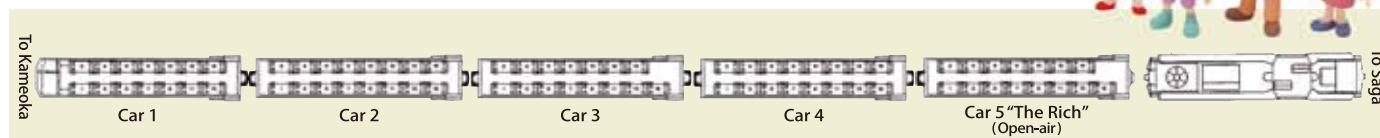

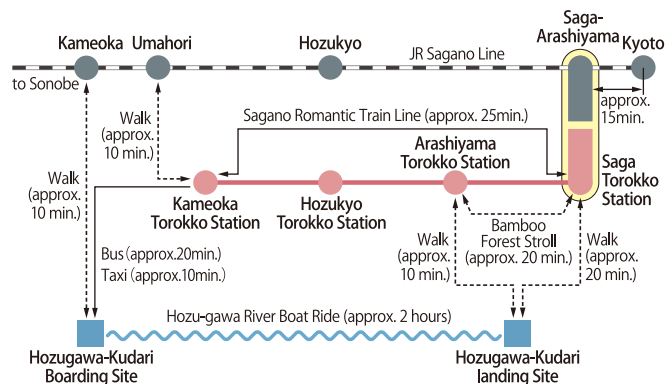

Four Seasons



Spring

Japan's national flower, the cherry blossom, blooms in abundance along the river gorge, which is one of Kyoto's most famous sites for cherry-blossoms.



Summer

The open-air train provides a cool and refreshing recreational ride. And the latest-model train, "The Rich", features an open grid floor which allows passengers to view the scenic landscape while still feeling the natural breezes.



Autumn

The river gorge is also renowned for its spectacular autumn maples. When riding the train during the autumnal changing of the leaves, the beautiful panorama of the autumn landscape spreads out before one's eyes.



Winter

The train ride also offers the chance to experience a beautiful ambience during the winter. Passengers tend to be fewer due to the cold weather, so one can more comfortably and leisurely relish the Hozukyo winter scenery.



1 Hozu-gawa River Boat Ride

For the trip back from Kameoka Station, why not take a thrilling boat ride down the Hozu River, enjoying the clean and clear spray of the Hozu River and listening to the interesting stories of the boatman.



2 Window View

Enjoy the landscape throughout the different seasons - the cherry blossoms of spring, the clear streams of summer and the maples of autumn....



3 Hozukyo Torokko Station

Hozukyo Torokko Station is a small station, which is located in the mountainous area of Mizuo. Mizuo is known as a place which produces citron fruit. This scenic area has been designated the Kyoto Prefectural Hozukyo Natural Park. Visitors can enjoy magnificent panoramic views from the station.



4 Hozu River Scenery

The train makes a short stop on the bridge across the river gorge, for passengers to enjoy the breathtaking scenery of the river gorge, which was formerly the main route for transporting timber down from the mountains.



5 Togetsukyo Bridge

A symbol of the Arashiyama area, the beautiful sight of this bridge has inspired numerous famous poets. In ancient times, boating and enjoying seasonal events here were elegant pastimes enjoyed by nobles.



6 Bamboo Forests

The Sagano-Arashiyama area near both the Sage and Arashiyama Torokko stations is renowned for its bamboo forests, and makes a splendid walking course.



7 Rental Bicycles

An inexpensive and fun way to tour the Sagano-Arashiyama area and Kameoka area is by bicycle. There are rent-a-cycle shops in front of Saga Torokko Station and Kameoka Station.



8 Saga Torokko Station

The station features refreshment and gift shops, and adjoins JR Saga-Arashiyama Station, making it easy to access from JR Kyoto Station, the main gateway to Kyoto.
